Die eiendom is geleë in die afdeling Oos-Londen, provinsie die Kaap die Goeie Hoop en die natuurreservaat sal bekend staan as die Fort Pato-natuurreservaat.

SETTING ASIDE OF A NATURE RESERVE

Under and by virtue of the powers vested in me by section 7 of the Forest Act, 1968 (Act 72 of 1968), as amended, I hereby set aside that portion of the East London Coast State Forest, called Pato Bush 847, of extent 691,775 4 ha in total, but excluding the servitude area of the Municipality of East London, in extent 15,7360 ha as described on Servitude Diagram SG3978/69, as a nature reserve for the preservation of fauna and flora. The property is situated in the Division of East London, Province of the Cape of Good Hope, and the nature reserve will be known as Fort Pato Nature Reserve.
