Situated in the administrative district of Venterstad and the boundaries whereof are as indicated on diagram ANO.16/7/3/1 which is filed on file ANO.6/3/2 in the office of the Director: Nature and Environmental Conservation, Provincial Building, Dorp Street, Cape Town, and copies of which are available for inspection at the office of the Officer-in-Charge, Oviston Nature Reserve, Venterstad, and the office of the Secretary of the Grootrivier Divisional Council at Colesberg. Special attention is drawn to the fact that the high-water mark on the Cape side of the H. F. Verwoerd Dam is regarded as the boundary.
